FPWA Approved Clinical Preceptors

FPWA is keen to encourage skilled and experienced sexual health clinicians with the appropriate theoretical training to become external clinical preceptors. Approved external clinical preceptors are authorised to supervise and assess clinicians during their clinical practicum for FPWA Certificate courses.

Prospective preceptors will need to complete a **Clinical Preceptor Workshop** and a peer review clinical session with an FPWA clinician.

The **Clinical Preceptor Workshop** includes the Clinical Instruction Workshop above, together with an additional afternoon session (1.00pm – 3.00pm) on the same day. This workshop will review the content of the Clinical Practice component of the FPWA Certificate courses, the use of the Clinical Practice Portfolios and the roles and responsibilities of an FPWA clinical preceptor.
